Consequently, when they encounter a new problem or decision they must make, they react with a decision that seemed to work before.

Six Problem-Solving Steps. The most effective method uses both rational and intuitive or creative approaches. There are six steps in the process: Identify the problem; Search for alternatives; Weigh the alternatives; Make a choice; Implement the choice; Evaluate the results and, if necessary, start the process again; Identify the problem. To solve a problem, you must first determine what the problem actually is.
