Reference List: Books // Purdue Writing Lab

The APA in-text citation for a book includes the author's last name, the year, and (if relevant) a page number. In the reference list, start with the author's last name and initials, followed by the year. The book title is written in sentence case (only capitalize the first word and any proper nouns).

An APA in-text citation includes only three items: the last name(s) of the author(s), the year the source was published, and sometimes the page or location of the information. References include more information such as the name of the author(s), the year the source was published, the full title of the source, and the URL or page range.

APA citation basics. When using APA format, follow the author-date method of in-text citation. This means that the author's last name and the year of publication for the source should appear in the text, for example, (Jones, 1998), and a complete reference should appear in the reference list at the end of the paper.

For every in-text citation in your paper, there must be a corresponding entry in your reference list. APA style is a common requirement for papers written in the social sciences. When you are using a textbook as a source in your References list, you cite it the same way you would cite any other book. Type the first author's name. You type her last name first, followed by a comma, followed by her initials.

For a reprinted work (a work that has been published in two places at once), provide both years in the in-text citation, separated with a slash, with the earlier year first. Provide the title, page range, editor, year of publication, and publisher of the original work in parentheses after the information about the work that you used.

Edited Book Chapter References - APA Style

Elements will change depending on the resource (a blog, article, legal materials, etc.). Depending on the citation style, a citation may include any of the following: title, author, date, page numbers, publisher, place of publication, link, doi, etc.

APA Referencing Basics: In-Text Citation In-text references must be included following the use of a quote or paraphrase taken from another piece of work. In-text citations are citations within the main body of the text and refer to a direct quote or paraphrase. They correspond to a reference in the main reference list.

How to Cite Sources in APA Citation Format - Mendeley

Place a parenthetical citation either immediately after the quotation or at the end of the sentence. For a narrative citation, include the author and year in the sentence and then place the page number or other location information in parentheses after the quotation.

Author's Citation in APA Format The author's name is the most important part of any citation. You have to write the author's name at the beginning of the citation in the APA format. If you are sourcing information from multiple authors, mention the initials of first and middle name and write the complete last name.
