In 2013, the AHA published a Consensus Statement focused on strategies to improve CPR quality. 6 In 2015, the ILCOR ACLS Task Force evaluated the available clinical evidence to determine whether using physiologic feedback to guide CPR quality improved survival and neurologic outcome.

In the cases where clinical signs and symptoms propose the diagnosis of tension pneumothorax for a patient, ATLS guidelines have recommended that an angiocatheter or needle should be inserted to the chest cavity in the 2nd intercostal space at the mid-clavicular line, in order to deflate the air which is trapped in the pleural cavity.

### **Information for Educators**

The ACLS recommendations in the 2010 guidelines 13 and the 2015 AHA guidelines update 12 state that it is reasonable to consider administering a 1-mg dose of intravenous/intraosseous epinephrine every 3 to 5 minutes during adult CPR.

ATLS continues to support the use of a 3-for-1 rule (3 mL of crystalloid should be used as replacement for every 1 mL of blood loss), but also encourages frequent reassessments if large amounts of crystalloid are not providing adequate resuscitation. ATLS also dictates treatment based on the class of hypovolemic shock.
