It was linked by a Roman road to the Roman fort and settlement at Derventio to the southeast, and thence by another road northeast to the regional hub of Luguvalium. The fort of Maryport lies on the Cumbrian coast, some 24 Roman miles south-south west of the western end of Hadrian's Wall. The visible fort survives as an earthwork, approximately square in shape and covering 1.96 hectares over the ramparts.

Maryport - with a Roman fort and large civilian settlement - was a key part of the frontier coastal defences extending from Hadrian's Wall and is now part of the 150 mile Hadrian's Wall World Heritage Site.
