A student who does not pass a subject in 3 chances is required to withdraw from the program. Viva voce is conducted for borderline students and to confirm distinctions.

The BDS is a 4-year course and 1 year internship offered by MCOADS. Formative and summative assessments are carried out. At the end of year II, pre-clinical exercises on phantom head using typodont teeth and viva voce. At the end of year IV part II, theory exams include essay type and MCQs. Practical exams include clinical case study, restorations on patients and viva voce.

Preparing for the sub stage: Sub stages are the regular viva voce that are held once every two weeks or so. The class is divided into 10-15 student batches, and each batch gives their viva voce to a certain examiner. Sub stages are lesser course, more tension. So the best way of preparing for them is to do them along with the lectures.
